

## (File System) Scavenger Hunt

## Instructions

- 1. For this hunt, you will be using File Explorer (Windows) or Finder (Mac). Please explore, play around and ask questions if you get stuck.
- 2. If you are the competitive type, then start a timer on your phone (or another device) so you can add your name and time to the score board when you have finalised all 10 tasks.

## The Hunt List

- 1. Find and Open a Specific Folder:
  - □ Locate the "Documents" folder on your computer.
  - □ Find and open a subfolder named "DTU" (create it if it doesn't exist).
- 2. Create a New Folder:
  - □ Within the "DTU" folder, create a new folder named "Semester1".
- 3. Move a File:
  - □ Create a text file named "example.txt" on your Desktop).
  - □ Write some text, anything, in the file.
  - □ Save the file.
  - □ Move "example.txt" into the "Semester1" folder.

## 4. Rename a File:

- □ Within the "Semester1" folder, rename "example.txt" to " ScavengerHunt.txt".
- 5. Copy a File:
  - □ Copy " ScavengerHunt.txt" to the "Documents" folder.
- 6. Create a Hierarchical Folder Structure:
  - □ Within "Semester1", create folders named "ITCafe" and "Programming".
  - □ Within "ITCafe", create a folder named "Activities".
  - □ Within "Programming", create a folder named "Projects".
- 7. Find and Open a Recently Downloaded File:



- Download a file from the internet (ScavengerHunt.pdf from [https://pythonsupport.dtu.dk/dropincafe/index.html]).
- □ Locate the downloaded file in the Downloads folder.
- □ Move the file to the "Activities" folder within "ITCafe".
- 8. Explore Memory and File Editing:
  - □ Open "ScavengerHunt.txt" and write: "I'm exploring memory and file editing" without saving.
  - □ Move the file to a different folder while it's still open.
  - □ Save the file and observe what happens.
- 9. Search for a File:
  - □ Use the search feature in File Explorer or Finder to find a file containing the word "memory".
  - □ Move this file to the "Activities" folder within "ITCafe".
- 10. Experiment with File Paths:
  - Write down the full path for the "ScavengerHunt.pdf" file (for ScavengerHunt.txt it would be, `C:\Users\Name\Documents\ScavengerHunt.txt` for Windows or `/Users/Name/Documents/ScavengerHunt.txt` for Mac).
  - □ Write down the new path would look, if you were to move the file to a different folder.
